A light lunch will be served, and a summary report on Transformation 2.0 will be presented.

## **A New Kind of Bible Study – What Does the Bible Say About Our Missions**

Would you like to be an active participant in a new kind of Bible study in Community of Faith? After our mission fair on October 30, we plan to kick off a new mission-focused adult Bible study, starting on November 6. 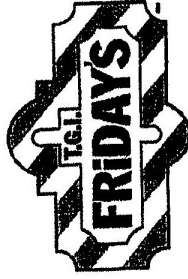
