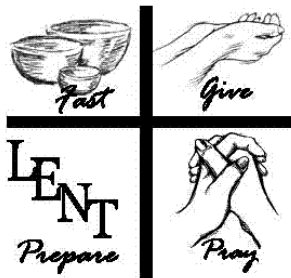

If you want to come but need child care, please let me know and we'll set something up! Hope to see you all there!



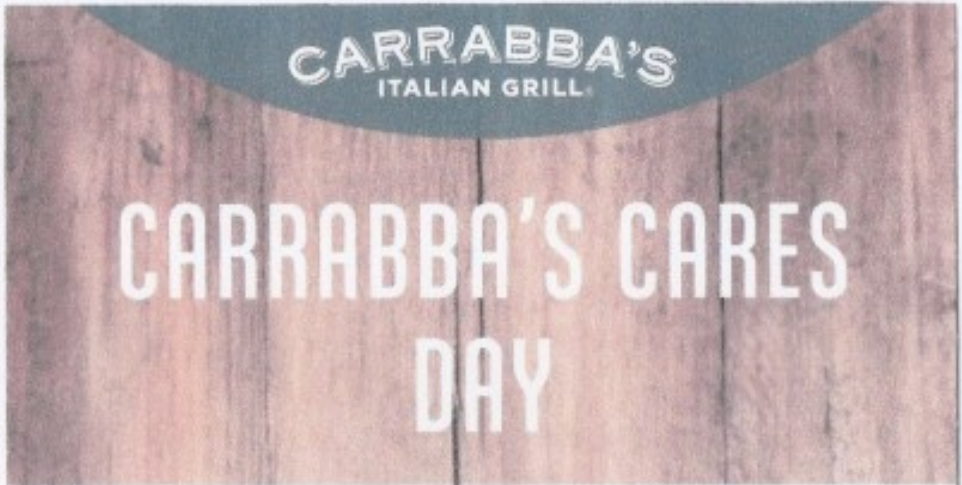
We will be making palm crosses on Saturday, **April 8th at 10:00am**. Everyone is welcome to participate. Please mark your calendar.
