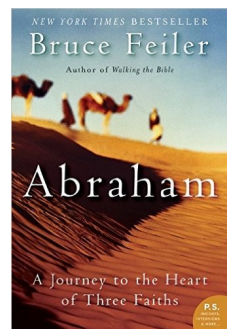

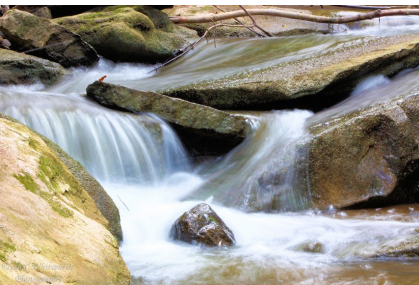
## **WORLD VISION GLOBAL 6K FOR WATER**
