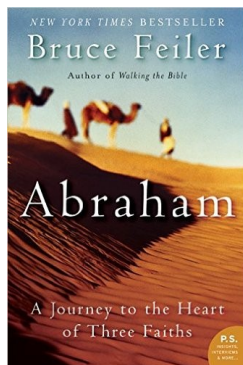


Disability Inclusion Sunday
