## Advent Giving Opportunities:

These include the PCUSA Joy Gift offering, Buckhorn, the Giving Tree, and Be Concerned (In addition to Nicaragua, mentioned below). Your Mission team suggests that we concentrate our giving on these known causes and non-profit organizations, with which we have had strong ties for many years. We invite you to contribute to one, two, three, or all of these causes. They are: Joy Gift offering (one of the 4 "special" annual offerings to the PCUSA); Buckhorn, the children's home with locations in Kentucky and Ohio; the Giving Tree, which provided gifts to disadvantaged children in the Ludlow community; and BeConcerned, a food bank, serving Covington and Kenton County. We also hope that you won't forget Nicaragua, helping our mission partner, CEPAD, to provide emergency relief to rural communities, ravaged by the twin hurricanes. ## Giving Opportunity - Hurricane Emergency Relief in Nicaragua through CEPAD:

As we pointed out in our spring request for contributions for CEPAD in Nicaragua, CEPAD has been working for the past 5 years with 40 villages located all over Nicaragua. The 40 villages where CEPAD has been working are all in the rural parts of the country where poverty is high and many families struggle to earn or grow enough to feed themselves. All of their struggles have been magnified by the devastating 1-2 punch of Hurricanes Eta and Iota. CEPAD needs more funding than ever before for emergency relief. They must try to meet the overwhelming challenges caused by torrential rains that face communities over half the country, not just the Atlantic coastal areas. CEPAD is looking to buy seeds for quick-growing crops because this is their growing season. Farmer's and villager's crops were washed away. They need to be able to replant right away. In addition, CEPAD wants to purchase the corrugated tin roofing material to help those whose roofs were destroyed. We plan to supplement your contributions with part of our general mission offerings. Because of the urgency of the need in Nicaragua, we are asking that you forward your contributions (by mail or online) by December 15.
